£4.25—3—14 year olds

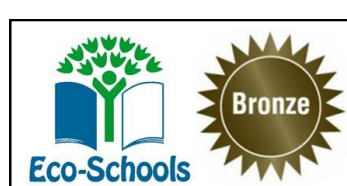
